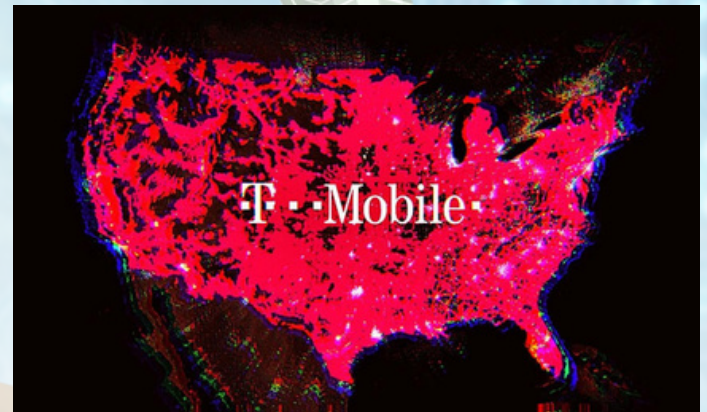


### \$1.1 Million Ransom

A \$1.1 million payment has been made to regain control of the San Bernardino, California police department's computer network following a ransomware attack.

The attack, which started as a service outage, was also investigated by the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI). In the meantime, investigations continue to determine the damages and identification of the authors.
