The FBI has warned Gmail and Outlook users to increase vigilance for e-mails that appear to come from a legitimate sender. This type of attack, identified by the FBI as Business Email Compromise (BEC), can take users' sensitive business data.

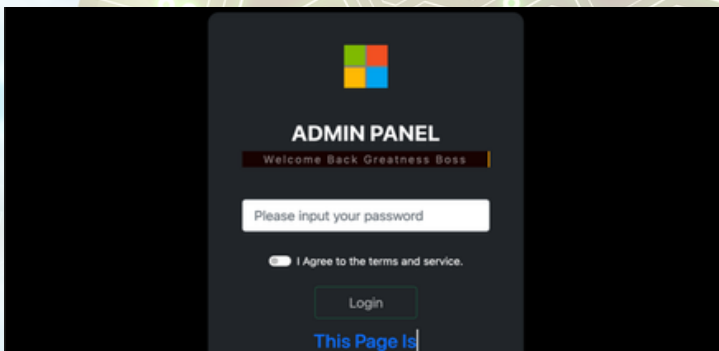


### Toyota has acknowledged the data breach that spanned a decade and affected 2.15 million customers.

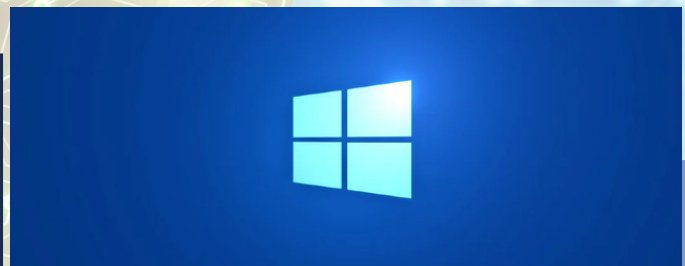


### "Greatness" - the new phishing-as-a-service platform
