Albania wins first place in the United Arab Emirates for cyber security

Albania wins the **FIRST PLACE** in the GISEC Global Cyber Security Competition, which was developed by the United Nations Agency ITU (International Telecommunication Union) and the Cyber Security Council of the United Arab Emirates, in Dubai.

This competition entered the Guinness Book, due to the high number of participating countries, from which Albania highlighted the expertise and serious commitment to address the complexity of cyber security in a world where technological developments have a dizzying speed.
